<u>Sunday, (Apr 2)</u> – On that blessed Palm Sunday, Jesus came to us as a Gentle and Humble King. He came to bring each one of us Peace. Pray that we will embrace this Peace that our Lord Jesus offers with much gratefulness in our hearts. Pray that as we proclaim the Lord Jesus in our lives, we may never be tempted to turn our back on Jesus. Pray that we will allow Jesus to be the King of Kings and the Lord of Lords of our lives. Pray for a deeper appreciation and understanding of Jesus' love as we enter into the final week of Lent.

Monday, (Apr 3) – Pray and commit to the Lord the various worship services during the Holy Week: Maundy Thursday, Good Friday, Combined Easter Sunrise Service and Easter. Pray that God will speak to us through these services. Pray that that those who have yet to know or embrace Jesus will respond positively towards the Good News of Jesus.
