PRAYERS FOR THE WEEK



<u>Sunday, (Jan 12)</u>: Heavenly Father, what a beautiful example the Lord Jesus Christ set by washing his disciples' feet, demonstrating how we should follow suit. Pray that we will decrease in everything we say and do so that the new life in Christ will increase in us to reflect our lives lived in love and truth as well as humility and grace, so that Christ can be seen in us as we die to self and live for Him. Pray that God would continue to grant us grace, humility, joy and a sacrificial heart, so that we do not lose the beauty of sacrifice or the joy of serving others. Pray that we may walk as Christ walked and live our lives as he lived in spirit and in truth, in humble obedience to His voice, complete reliance on His provision, and grateful gratitude for what Christ has done for us.

Monday, (Jan 13): Church: We thank God for His faithfulness and His enduring love for Klang Wesley. We thank God for the ministries that He has entrusted to us. Pray that we will earnestly seek God for His will and guidance for all ministries and depend on His provision. May He reveal His plans for us and provide our needs. Pray that God will bless and guide every leader and committee member, as they partner with God for His work to be done through the church. Pray for the unity, mutual support and care in the team of each ministry.

Tuesday, (Jan 14): Pray for protection and wellbeing of God's ministers who work among an undocumented people group, who is under surveillance by the authorities that God is truly their tower of refuge, and their source of strength, joy, and peace. Pray for God's supernatural intervention in annihilating Africa's mob violence, which is increasingly being used as a weapon against religious minorities in Nigeria, with Christians especially vulnerable to attacks provoked by blasphemy accusations. Pray that God will provide supernatural grace, strength, and love to our Christian brothers and sisters in North Korea who have experienced great persecution so that they do not lose hope that God's kingdom will break through in this nation of darkness.

<u>Wednesday, (Jan 15)</u>: Pray for the Nation – Pray for everyone to remain vigilant and take preventive measures against any potential viral outbreaks in light of the human metapneumovirus (HMPV) situation in China, since prevention and monitoring are even more important because there is no vaccine or specific treatment for hMPV. Pray for relief from the constant rain, especially in the East Coast and East Malaysia, and that flooding recede swiftly and safely, allowing affected communities to begin their recovery process. Pray for strength and safety for all rescue workers, emergency responders, and volunteers who work tirelessly in flood-affected areas.

<u>Thursday, (Jan 16)</u>: TRAC: Pray for all our District Superintendents as they go about chairing the various Local Conferences in their respective Districts. Pray for God's wisdom to be upon them as they lead and guide the churches under their District. Pray for the Lord's anointing and enablement to be upon them. Guard their hearts and minds and that they would not neglect time with God in the midst of busyness. Pray for journey mercies as they travel.

Friday, (Jan 17): As global concern has grown over the recent increased cases of HMPV in some countries, pray for God's protection and healing. Pray for God's wisdom upon the WHO, international leaders and authorities in monitoring, updating and sharing information so that we can receive prompt and appropriate advice. While cold and flu-like symptoms are common in countries with a winter season, pray that we remain calm and vigilant by wearing a mask in a crowd and maintaining good hygiene practice. Pray for God's protection upon the vulnerable – the sick, small children, and the elderly.

<u>Saturday, (Jan 18)</u>: Pray for the World: Pray for God's comfort to be upon the victims of the historic natural disaster, the wildfire in Los Angels where the lives of people, many buildings and the many memorable possessions were lost. Pray that God, in His mercy, will bring rain and calm the wind so that the fire will not spread any further. Pray for restoration and healing in the lives of people and on the land. Pray that the victims receive physical and emotional support and care. Pray for protection upon the firefighters and rescuers.
