PRAYERS FOR THE WEEK



<u>Sunday, (Apr 6)</u>: Lord, we express gratitude to You for Your sovereignty over the nations, foretelling their rise and fall, and for Your assurance of our lives' safety amidst uncertainties and conflicts. Pray for peace and justice in this world and let Your kingdom and righteousness be established and reign. Pray for our faith to remain steadfast in darkest times, trusting that You will bring ultimate victory to those who remain faithful to You. Pray that just as You have given Daniel insight, You would grant us discernment to navigate the challenges we face today.

Monday, (Apr 7): Church: Pray for the candidates who will be baptised or/and received into the membership on April 13, during the Palm Sunday worship service. We thank God for their desires to confess our Lord Jesus as their Savior and God and to continue to grow in Klang Wesley. May God's grace and blessings to be upon them, as they prepare for the day. May they find strength, joy and hope in this new journey with Jesus. May we welcome them as a family in Christ and desire to grow together.

<u>Tuesday, (Apr 8)</u>: Pray for a resilient church that would walk and not grow weary (Isaiah 40:31) in sub-Saharan Africa which continues to be the deadliest place on earth for God's people, where they are killed for their faith in the Lord. Pray for hidden manna for persecuted believers in North Korea and for God's supernatural intervention to open the country to the gospel. Pray that God would raise up churches in the most difficult and unexpected places where Christians are severely persecuted and marginalised.

Wednesday, (Apr 9): Pray for the Nation – Pray for the victims of the Putra Heights gas pipeline fire on 1 April 2025, for their speedy recovery and healing from burns, wounds, and breathing difficulties. Pray for a swift and concerted action by the Selangor government and Petronas in repairing and rebuilding houses damaged by the gas pipeline fire, following the Prime Minister's call. We give thanks to the federal government for providing immediate financial aid to victims of a fire, the swift response of firefighters, and the support of mosques and a Hindu temple in turning into an emergency relief center for all victims regardless of race and religion.

<u>Thursday, (Apr 10)</u>: TRAC Pastors' School - This year the TRAC Pastors' School will be held in Kota Kinabalu, Sabah from the 22nd - 25th of April. Pray for all pastors who would be travelling to Sabah. Pray for journey mercies. Pray also for a good time of connecting with God and each other as we take time off to go for this school. Pray for teachable hearts as we learn from each other. Pray also for discerning hearts as we talk and discuss issues pertaining to the life of church.

<u>Friday, (Apr 11)</u>: Pray for those who are going through a difficult time in their lives and feel weary. May God comfort them with His presence and grant them peace to calm their hearts. Pray that God will satisfy their needs and grant them strength to endure. May He minister to them with His assurance of care and love, that they will find hope in Him alone. May God's healing and restoration come upon them.

<u>Saturday, (Apr 12)</u>: Pray for the World: Pray for Myanmar. Pray for God's comfort and healing to be upon the people and the land affected by the 7.7 magnitude earthquake. Pray for ongoing aids from international countries and agencies for various support, and that basic necessities such as clean drinking water, tents, food and medications would reach the people in need. Pray for rescuers' safety, as well as for missing people to be found and reunited with their families. Pray for unity among the people to support each other during this difficult time.
