### PRAYERS FOR THE WEEK



<u>Sunday, (Apr 13)</u>: Lord Jesus, as we reflect on your triumphal entry into Jerusalem, we come before you with hearts full of gratitude and praise. You are the King who comes in the name of the Lord, bringing peace and glory to heaven. Pray for a spirit of submission of our lives, akin to humble riding on a colt, showing us that true power comes from servanthood and grace. Pray for faithfulness and fortitude to believe in your plan even if it deviates from our expectations as we journey through Holy Week. Pray for personal transformation as we surrender to the Holy Spirit, transforming us from carnal to spiritual and allowing Christ to reign supreme in our lives.

Monday, (Apr 14): Church: As we entered the Holy week, may the Holy Spirit open our hearts to the richness of God's grace and love, His wisdom and power. We thank God that our Lord Jesus washed His disciples' feet in an extra ordinary act of humility and love, despite knowing that one of them would betray Him. We thank God for His sacrificial and unconditional love for us as manifested on the cross. We thank God for His power and wisdom in raising our Lord Jesus and leaving the tomb empty. May our hearts overflow with gratitude, hope and faith in Him. May we shine His light to the people around us in the community who need Jesus.

**Friday, (Apr 18):** We remember this day the pain and suffering of the cross, as well as all that our Lord Jesus endured in His obedience to the Father's will to become a perfect sacrifice to bear our sins and save us. May the Holy Spirit help us to recognize the cost of it all and truly appreciate that our sins are forgiven through the precious blood of our Lord Jesus, and we are given an eternal life as we place our trust in Him as our Saviour. May we turn away from sin and desire to live in obedience to God by His grace.

<u>Saturday</u>, (<u>Apr 19</u>): Pray for the World: As the world wrestles with the effects of U.S tariffs, pray that God will help the leaders in engaging in meaningful dialogue and cooperation, resulting in a peaceful and mutually beneficial agreement.
