Sunday, (June 18) – Give thanks to the Lord that we through our Lord Jesus are able to approach the Father's throne of grace. Pray that we will never be so familiar with the love of God that we no longer allow the love of God to change and transform our hearts. Pray that the love that God so lavished upon us will enable us to return to Him with repentance. Pray especially for all those who are back-slidden to experience God's tangible presence and love again. Pray that they will be courageous to take the first step of returning to the Father's heart. Pray that God will bring alongside those who are back-slidden friends who encourage them.

Monday, (June 19) – Commit to the Lord our Church Leadership. Pray for our leaders to walk closely with the Lord. Pray for an increase sense of sensitivity towards the leading and guidance of the Holy Spirit. Pray that our leaders will learn to listen to the still small voice of God that calls them first to be children of God. Pray that as we approach our Mid-year Review, we may be able to pause to recognize and give thanks to You for all that You have done in our church. Pray likewise for all CG Leaders that God may give the strength as they continue to persevere in the CG ministry.

Tuesday, (June 20) – Pray for parents to be positive role models in their families and communities by modelling Christ-like behaviour for their children. Pray for all fathers, biological or spiritual, to be blessed with patience, understanding, and compassion as they navigate the challenges of fatherhood. Pray for teenagers and young adults to grow in faith and strength in the Lord, as well as in stature and favour with God and man.
