Sunday, (June 25) – The path that leads to God is narrow. The gate that opens the way to life in the kingdom is small but Jesus urges us to choose to enter through the small gate for it leads to life. Pray for a deep and strong sense of perseverance to be with us as we endeavor to walk in obedience to all that Jesus has taught us. Pray for a deep sense of trust in God so that we may be able to surrender our lives to Him. Pray that God will surround us with people who are eager to walk closely with you so that by and through their actions, we may be encouraged to do likewise. Just like how the Psalmist declares in Psalms 1, pray that we will not choose to walk in the counsel of the wicked or stand in the way of sinners or sit in the seat of mockers but that we will choose to delight and meditate in the law of God.

Monday, (June 26) – We pray and commit to the Lord grieving families who have lost their loved ones recently. Pray for God's peace and comfort to be upon those who are grieving. Give thanks to the Lord for the eternal hope that we have in and through our Lord Jesus Christ. Help us to know deep down in our hearts that death will not separate us from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus. Pray that God will minister to grieving hearts and that they would be able to experience God's tangible presence and love in this time of bereavement.

Tuesday, (June 27) – Pray for a repentant and revitalised church that can reflect God's character to the rest of the world, especially in loving God and loving one another while pursuing holiness and righteousness. Pray for a reconciling Church that seeks humility in forgiving one another as God has forgiven us and living in unity as one body of Christ. Pray for a resilient Church, that God's grace and strength will enable His people to remain steadfast in the gospels and unwaveringly in following Jesus.
