Sunday, (July 9) – Let us lift up to God our children. Pray for God's continual blessings to be upon our children. Pray that as our children face difficulties, God you may give them strength to face it. Enable our children to learn from their mistakes and that we as the church will also learn to journey with our children. Pray that for the presence of God to be with our children in the midst of their vulnerability; pray for God's protection that would guard them against any lasting harm and pray that God will keep our children always in His love.

Monday, (July 10) – **CG Leaders Retreat** - Commit to the Lord seven of our CG Leaders who would be going for a retreat from the 28th - 30th July 2023. Pray that our CG Leaders to be refreshed and encouraged through this retreat. Pray also for our leaders to come to this retreat with a sense of openness and anticipation of what the Lord might be saying to them. Commit to the Lord also the retreat facilitator, Ms. Ng Wai Ling who would be leading the retreat. Pray that God's guidance to be with her as she prepares to lead this retreat.

Tuesday, (July 11) – Pray for a relentlessly compassionate church that is always looking for ways to meet the needs of those around us, as well as hearts moved by compassion to be a voice for the oppressed, a giver to the poor, and an encouragement to the disabled and elderly. Pray for a repentant and revived church that repents from our sins of pride and rebellion that have resulted in strife, division, and conflict, and that our hearts and minds are revived with a hunger and thirst for God's Word and obedience to His commands. Pray for the sick, asking God to work for their good and His glory, and know that God works for the good of those who love Him, regardless of life, death, sickness, or health.

Wednesday, (July 12) – **Pray for the Nation:** Pray for protection over the Judiciary, Legal, the MACC and AG office, that they will continue to administer justice without fear or favor. Pray against any parties bent on playing up and exploiting racial and religious sentiments to create chaos and disorder in the country during the upcoming state elections following the stern warning from the IGP against those playing up 3r (religion, royalty and race) issues in state polls. Pray for our government, the central bank, and the Ministry of Finance to have the foresight to devise a long-term strategy to address rising fiscal risks, a falling ringgit that will add to the worrisome economic malaise, and political stability.

Thursday, (July 13) – **TRAC:** Pray for Living Hope Methodist Church, Bukit Rimau as they work towards organizing their fund raising dinner in July. Pray for God's favor to be upon their efforts and that this will be an opportunity for the church to come together in order to work together. Pray also for the growth of the church. Pray that God will enable each member to grow deeper in their walk with God. Pray also that the church be able to reach out to their community with the love and gospel of Christ. Commit to the Lord the church pastor, Rev. Eric Tan and as well as the church leadership as they work together to accomplish God's purpose for the church.

Friday, (July 14) – Pray that educators will be able to provide reliable testimony, instill the value of fraternity over competition, and prioritise the welfare of the most vulnerable and young people. Pray for churches and parishes to become more welcoming, faith-based communities that embrace those in need and place communion at their core. Pray that church movements and missional organisations will daily rediscover their role in evangelization and use their unique gifts to meet the needs of the world.

Saturday (July 15) – **Pray for the World:** Pray for the implementation of effective measures to stop or at least lessen the long-lasting effects brought on by El Nino in the affected countries. Pray for North Korea because there are reports that the people there are going through great hardship and many of them are suffering because food is so scarce due to the totalitarian regime's poor governance. Pray for peace in Manipur and for an end to the conflict between the Meiteis, the main ethnic group in the lowlands, and the Kuki ethnic group.
