Sunday, (July 23) – Pray that our lives will indeed be a role model for other believers. Just like how the apostle Paul urged his church to imitate him as he imitates Christ, pray that we at Klang Wesley will live our lives according to God's ways and purposes. Pray that we ourselves will learn to imitate Christ in all our relationships that those who meet us will indeed meet Christ through us. Pray that we learn to be aware of our weakness and hence be humble, giving God all the glory that He deserves. Pray that we be gracious in all our dealings just as Christ has shown us grace and mercy.

Monday, (July 24) – CG Leaders Retreat - Commit to the Lord seven of our CG Leaders who would be going for a retreat from the 28th-30th July 2023. Pray that our CG Leaders to be refreshed and encouraged through this retreat. Pray for the ongoing restoration of unfulfilled rights and privileges under the Malaysia Agreement of 1963, which established Sabah and Sarawak as equal partners in the formation of Malaysia.

Thursday, (July 27) – TRAC: Pray for Living Hope Methodist Church, Bukit Rimau as they work towards organizing their fund raising dinner end of July. Pray for God's favor to be upon their efforts and that this will be an opportunity for the church to come together in order to work together. Pray also for the growth of the church. Pray that God will enable each member to grow deeper in their walk with God. Pray also that the church be able to reach out to their community with the love and gospel of Christ.
