Sunday, (July 30) – This Sunday is the final week that we are focusing on the theme **Family**. Let us continue to fervently pray for all families represented in Klang Wesley. Pray that Christ will indeed be at the center of each family. Pray that forgiveness and love and kindness to be expressed towards one another within the family. Pray for the head of the family, that God will grant the fathers and in some families, mothers the wisdom and courage that is needed to lead the family. Pray that families will grow closer to God together.

Monday, (July 31) – Pray for those who are grieving the loss of their loved ones. Pray that we will learn to grieve with hope knowing that God will call both the dead and living to Himself when Christ comes again in glory. Pray that God will use us to bring comfort to those who are grieving. Pray that the Lord will indeed teach us the church of what it means to be present with those who are in pain. Pray for the Lord's peace which surpasses all human understanding to rest upon those who are grieving.

Tuesday, (Aug 1) – Pray for the theme of A Renewed Church in all the Methodist Churches in Malaysia that will be an empowered Church being rooted in the Word of God and by the power of the Almighty God. Pray that a Renewed Church will enrich families by empowering them to serve as the core of the Christian community and agents for growth in the Christian faith by emulating John Wesley's sermon, "On Family Religion," focusing on the responsibility of parents to impart spiritual knowledge to their children. Pray that a Renewed Church to enhance the quality of the education it offers so that no child is denied of education that will help build the nation.

Wednesday, (Aug 2) – Pray for the Nation: Pray unceasingly for all eligible voters to exercise their solemn duty not only to vote but to influence countless others to vote correctly for the right nominated candidates with humility and integrity in the upcoming state elections in Selangor, Penang, Negeri Sembilan, Kedah, Kelantan and Terengganu on August 12, 2023. Pray for peace at this time leading up to the state elections so that the security forces will be on high alert to protect the nation from any parties attempting to create chaos and racial disharmony by inciting the 3Rs (race, religion, and royalty). Pray for the ongoing restoration of unfulfilled rights and privileges under the Malaysia Agreement of 1963, which established Sabah and Sarawak as equal partners in the formation of Malaysia and needs to be implemented.

Thursday, (Aug 3) – Methodist Church in Malaysia: Pray for a good participation in the **Pray for Malaysia Online Prayer Gathering** which happens once a month. In the month of August, this prayer gathering has been brought forward to the 6th of August in light of the upcoming state elections. Pray that God will hear us when we as His people come together in prayer for our nation. Pray that God will raise more intercessors who will see intercession as a ministry unto the Lord. Pray that God will raise more intercessors among those of us in Klang Wesley.

Friday, (Aug 4) – Continue to pray for God's mercy, as we experience El Nino effect, which is accompanied by increasing heat, drought or rainfall in different parts of the world. Pray for God's protection to be upon the lives of people and livestock. Pray for God's provision that the effect on the crops will not be severe and will not result in a shortage of daily necessities. Pray for God's wisdom and guidance to be upon the international authorities and meteorological agencies to monitor and to provide in advance the information on the continuing growth and effect of El Nino.

Saturday (Aug 5) – Pray for the World: Pray for Niger as soldiers declared a coup and the Nigerien army endorsed the coup leaders last week. Pray that the nation will remain peaceful and orderly without violence. Pray for God's mercy upon the country that a peaceful dialogue will take place and that the leaders of the country will work to safeguard the nation's democracy, freedom and political stability, as well as welfare and rights of its citizens.
