Sunday, (Aug 20) – We praise and thank God for the ministry of Methodist Women in Klang Wesley. God is doing His work of ministry and engaging the community through the MW Ministry. Pray that God will use the MW Ministry to touch even more lives in the community. Pray that God will raise up younger leaders to lead the MW Ministry in our church. Pray for women in our church be empowered and pray that God will give them the courage to do His work among people.

Monday, (Aug 21) – Commit to the Lord the church **leadership (both the LCEC and CG Leaders)**. Pray first and foremost that God will draw us into a deeper relationship with Him. Pray that God will keep the leaders united as we begin to seek God's direction for 2024 & 2025 and possibly leading up to our 125th Church anniversary in 2026. Pray for a discerning heart and spirit that we will only do that which God is leading us into. Pray for good relationships among church leaders as well.

Tuesday, (Aug 22) – Pray for churches in Malaysia where children, youth, and adults attend different services and participate in separate activities to strengthen intergenerational relationships in order to close the generation gap and promote redemptive conversations among their members. Pray that the Holy Spirit will continue to inspire mission schools to have an impact on the 462 schools that are currently in existence (235 of which are in Sabah and Sarawak). Pray that every church in Malaysia will prioritise Christian education that is based on the Bible, as the highest priority as they take on the responsibility of making disciples of all nations.

Wednesday, (Aug 23) – **Pray for the Nation:** Prayer of thanksgiving to the recent six states' elections that have gone in a peaceful manner, with the unity government triumphed in the three states, namely, Selangor, Penang and Negeri Sembilan. Continue to pray for our unity government to be able to address the post-pandemic rise in living expenses and lessen the burden on typical households by implementing wise economic policies that balance the needs of both the manufacturing and supply-chain sectors. Pray for God's comfort and peace to be upon the families of the ten people killed when an aircraft carrying them crashed in the Elmina township in Shah Alam after taking off from Langkawi International Airport and heading to Subang.

Thursday, (Aug 24) – **TRAC** : Commit to the Lord the upcoming **TRAC Joint Boards** that will take place from the **8th - 10th September** Pray for God's direction and guidance to be upon all Board Chairpersons. Pray for attentiveness to the promptings of the Holy Spirit in doing all that God intends to do through the various boards in TRAC. Pray for our TRAC President, Rev. Joshua Khong as he leads the entire conference. Pray that God will indeed give him clarity and that God will also surround him with people who may encourage and work alongside him.

Friday, (Aug 25) – Pray for the students and teachers who begin school holidays that God will keep them safe, especially those who are travelling. Pray for wisdom and vigilance in all that they undertake. Pray that they will experience God's love and grace during this holiday, and this may be a time of quietness and rest in the Lord, as well as a time of reconnecting with family and friends.

Saturday (Aug 26) – **Pray for the World:** Pray for the people around the world who have been affected by the recent natural disasters including the wildfires in Hawaii and Canada, the floods, and the landslides in India, China and Myanmar. Pray for God's comfort to be upon the families of the victims and pray that every person who is missing will be found and brought home. Pray for God's mercy and intervention upon the rescue and recovery efforts.
