PRAYERS FOR THE WEEK



<u>Sunday, (Aug 27)</u> – To experience the severe mercies of God is hard. Sometimes God takes us through difficulties in order to mold us into His likeness. Pray for God's strength to be upon all those who are experiencing some form of struggle or may even find themselves in the midst of a storm. Pray that these storms in life would not draw us further away from God but instead it would yield its purpose in transforming our lives; shaping us towards all that God may call us to do. Pray that God will bring about people who would be willing to journey with those who are in the midst of a life storm.

Monday, (Aug 28) – Commit to the Lord the church leadership (both the LCEC and CG Leaders). Pray first and foremost that God will draw us into a deeper relationship with Him. Pray that God will keep the leaders united as we begin to seek God's direction for 2024 & 2025 and possibly leading up to our 125th Church anniversary in 2026. Pray for a discerning heart and spirit that we will only do that which God is leading us into. Pray for good relationships among church leaders as well.

<u>Tuesday, (Aug 29)</u> – Pray for the faithful pastors and workers among the indigenous groups in Malaysia who continue to serve them diligently and quietly in order to help them grow spiritually. Pray for these indigenous groups to be set free from superstition and animistic beliefs, and to come to know our Lord Jesus Christ's saving power and grace as their personal Lord and Savior. Pray for the protection of the Orang Asli land customary rights, so that they are not exploited, deforested, or harmed by environmental degradation.

Wednesday, (Aug 30) – Pray for the Nation: Giving thanks to God for our country's 66th Independence Day, which will be celebrated on August 31, 2023 and praying for Malaysia Madani: as this year's theme of the National Day and Malaysia Day 2023 celebration, "Determination of Unity Fulfils Hope," our government's determination and commitment to develop the country with the people being united, possessing a high spirit of unity, and living in peace and prosperity. Pray that the Government comprising of various political blocs, to reach a growing consensus on their vision, purpose, and goal of making Malaysia as a great nation as they work together to provide leadership for the country. Pray for a just, fair, and equitable resolution to unfulfilled rights and privileges under the Malaysia Agreement of 1963, which states that Sabah and Sarawak are equal partners with the Federation of Malaya in the formation of Malaysia.

<u>Thursday, (Aug 31)</u> – **TRAC**: Commit to the Lord the upcoming **TRAC Joint Boards** that will take place from the **8th** - **10th September** Pray for God's direction and guidance to be upon all Board Chairpersons. Pray for attentiveness to the promptings of the Holy Spirit in doing all that God intends to do through the various boards in TRAC. Pray for our TRAC President, Rev. Joshua Khong as he leads the entire conference. Pray that God will indeed give him clarity and that God will also surround him with people who may encourage and work alongside him.

<u>Friday, (Sept 1)</u> – Pray for the families, friends, neighbours and colleagues who have not yet come to have faith in our Lord Jesus Christ. Pray that the Holy Spirit will put into our hearts the names of those people and lead us to pray for them unceasingly. Pray that God will grant us the opportunity and courage to share the gospel with them. Pray that the Holy Spirt will soften their hearts and work in them to hear and accept our Lord Jesus as their personal Lord and Saviour by God's grace and His perfect timing.

<u>Saturday (Sept 2)</u> – <u>Pray for the World</u>: Pray that God with His mercy will protect the people and the environment, as Japan has started releasing Advanced Liquid Processing System treated water from the Fukushima Daiichi Nuclear Power Station into the sea. Pray that the country's leaders, Tokyo Electric Power Company and the International Atomic Energy Agency will ensure that the relevant international safety standards continue to be applied and they will provide the update information with transparency. Pray that they will also be sensitive to the concerns of people in the nation as well as other countries and willing to hear the opinions from international agencies, and even to review their plans if there is a necessity.
