### **PRAYERS FOR THE WEEK**



<u>Sunday, (Sept 3)</u> – Pray for a greater sense of appreciation and thankfulness for all that Jesus has done for us as we approach the Lord's Table today. Pray that we will truly experience the deep love of God not just in our minds but also in our hearts as well. Pray that no one will be hindered from responding to God's love and pray that God will remove all hurdles that people may have in coming to the Lord in faith. Pray that we will have a desire to share the Goodnews of Jesus wherever God has placed us. Pray that the way we live our lives as disciples will be a testimony to people.

Monday, (Sept 4) – Commit to the Lord the church leadership (both the LCEC and CG Leaders). Pray first and foremost that God will draw us into a deeper relationship with Him. Pray that God will keep the leaders united as we begin to seek God's direction for 2024 & 2025 and possibly leading up to our 125th Church anniversary in 2026.
