PRAYERS FOR THE WEEK



<u>Sunday, (Sept 24)</u> – Jesus teaches that we ought to persist and not give up in praying (Luke 18: 1). Pray that we will not be easily discouraged but instead just like the widow in Jesus' parable, we will persist in seeking God. Pray that we will continue to bring before the concerns of our hearts trusting that God is a God who is merciful. Let us hold on unswervingly to the fact that our God is a God who hears our cries and answers them accordingly. Pray also that we may encourage a fellow believer to persevere in prayer with our own journey of prayer.

<u>Monday, (Sept 25)</u> – Commit to the Lord our church leadership (LCEC & CG Leaders) as we prepare to go through a process of discerning God's direction for our church. Pray for strength and perseverance as we go through some teaching sessions that would enable us to see God's purpose for the church. Pray also that God will begin to speak to each of our leaders of His will for Klang Wesley. Pray for attentiveness and the gift of listening as we listen to one another during those sessions.

<u>Tuesday, (Sept 26)</u> – Pray that women's ministries in churches and para-churches are biblical, current, and relevant to the needs of women from diverse backgrounds. Pray that the ministries will also equip women believers to have a long-term impact in their marketplaces and communities. Pray that God will reveal ways for the Church to help women grow closer to one another and to Christ by supporting one another and growing in faith and spiritual knowledge.

Wednesday, (Sept 27) – Pray for the Nation: Pray for the work being done ahead of Budget 2024, as well as for important bills that will be introduced, such as the Children's Commission, Parliamentary Services, and amendments to the Federal Constitution granting children citizenship rights. Pray for Members of Parliament to fulfil their duties as elected representatives of the rakyat, as well as for proposals to remove their daily sitting allowance for absenteeism and to increase fines for impolite behaviour in Parliament. Pray for fair proportionate representation and opportunities for Sabah and Sarawak's indigenous people, particularly in politics and public service.

<u>Thursday, (Sept 28)</u> – TRAC: Commit to the Lord all **District Superintendents** as they approach this season of conducting various Local Conferences in the churches of their respective districts. Pray for a good time management in carrying out their DS duties and responsibilities. Pray for God's guidance to be upon our DSs and pray for the ability to lead and counsel especially in difficult situations. Pray for God's protection to be upon them as they travel around and pray that God will also keep their families safe.

<u>Friday, (Sept 29)</u> – Pray for family. Pray for God's protection and guidance upon each member of the family, and His Spirit will encourage them to trust in Him each day. Pray that God in His love and mercy bring the family together, instil patience and understanding in their hearts, and keep the family in unity of love and mutual support. Pray that the grace of God to be upon the parents and guardians that they will set a good example, and children will respect and honour them, too. May God's forgiveness and healing take place, and may His peace rule over every family.

<u>Saturday (Sept 30)</u> – Pray for Israel and Palestine. Pray for God's intervention that there will be peace, justice, hope, and respect for all people. Pray that basic human rights to be advocated. Pray for strength, endurance and patience so that both parties can negotiate peacefully. Pray that God will draw those who are hurting and grieving, and He will heal and comfort them. Pray that the gospel of peace will be spread.
