PRAYERS FOR THE WEEK



<u>Sunday, (Nov 19)</u> – Pray that God's people would continue to build themselves up in the most holy faith that was once delivered to them, by taking delight in reading, meditating on and reflecting His Word as well as praying in the Holy Spirit constantly. Pray for God's people to keep themselves in God's love by constantly abiding in Christ and to eagerly await for him, who will bring us eternal life at his second coming. Pray that God's people will show mercy to those who doubt the gospel and pull them out of the fire so they don't perish.

Monday, (Nov 20) – Church Planning Retreat: Commit to the Lord the upcoming Church Planning Retreat that will take place from the 24th - 26th of November. Pray that as both the LCEC as well as the CG Leaders come together, we may be united in seeking and discerning God's direction for our church. Pray that as leadership come together, we may once again reconnect with God and with one another.
