Sunday, (Dec 10) – Immanuel: God with Us - Pray that the truth of Immanuel who is God with us to be impressed upon our hearts strongly. *A bruised reed He will not break, a smoldering wick He will not snuff out-* such is the gentleness of Christ. Pray that the gentleness of Christ will be the source of strength to those who are weak. Pray that those who are experiencing a season of tiredness and fatigue in their lives will indeed draw near to Jesus who is gentle. Pray for Jesus to be our source of encouragement as we continue to live our lives as disciples of Jesus.

Monday, (Dec 11) – Commit to the Lord for preparations for **Christmas**. Pray especially for the worship team, the dance team, the visual and media team as they prepare for the Christmas message. Pray that we as a church, we will truly come together and adore Jesus with all our hearts. Pray also for the Christmas message that it would bear fruit in the hearts of our congregation.

Tuesday, (Dec 12) – Pray for the Church to share the gospel with the lost, for the sick to experience God's healing touch, and for the marginalised to be shielded from injustice, exploitation, and discrimination. Pray for the children's divine protection, especially from the world culture of the digital age, which tempts them away the love of God. Pray for the church to be a model of family parenting that exemplifies Christlike behavior for their children and to foster a sense of community among them.

Wednesday, (Dec 13) – **Pray for the Nation:** Pray for continuous steadfast reforms that the government is carrying out to address poverty, higher cost of living, food shortage and rising prices and the weak ringgit. Pray for protection from the rise of a new strain of covid, dengue fever, tuberculosis and influenza A. Pray for God's protection and peace for the people of SG4 states (Perlis, Kedah, Kelantan and Terengganu) especially those who are facing poverty, oppression and discrimination.

Thursday, (Dec 14) – **TRAC:** Commit to the Lord all pastors who would be going on transfer at the end of this year. Pray for the presence of Christ who is our Immanuel to be with both pastors and the respective congregations as they move forward. Pray for pastors and congregations to have proper closures. Pray that the friendships fostered will live on. Where there may have been hurt, pray for forgiveness to be extended to each other.

Friday, (Dec 15) – There has been about a 57.3% increase in Covid-19 cases recorded during the week of November 19 to 25, compared to the cases recorded from the previous week, according to the last week's newspaper. May God heal those who are afflicted and grant them a speedy recovery. Pray that God will give everyone the discernment to be cautious and take preventive steps, such as practicing good personal cleanliness. Pray for God's protection, especially for young children, the elderly, expectant mothers, and those suffering from chronic diseases.

Saturday (Dec 16) – **Pray for the World:** Pray that the good news of our Lord Jesus Christ will reach every person on the earth. Pray that every knee will bow down and every tongue will confess that Jesus is the Lord. Pray for the areas in the world where Christians face persecution and discrimination. Pray for God's protection upon every brother and sister. May He heal those who have been harmed physically and emotionally. May the Lord always stand at the side of every brother and sister and gave them strength to stay firm in their faith. Pray that He will work mightily among the areas that His Name will be made known despite the opposition.
