Sunday, (May 26): Just like how our Lord Jesus had revealed Himself to Nathanael, pray that Jesus would also reveal Himself to us. Pray for a deep conviction within our hearts that would compel us to come to Jesus. Pray also for a desire to want to share about Jesus with others and that God would give us opportunities to bring others to Jesus.

<u>Monday, (May 27)</u>: WMCK Church Camp - Commit to the Lord the church camp. Pray for a smooth running of the camp. Pray that God will already begin to prepare our hearts to listen to what God has to say to us through Dato Dr. Daniel Ho. Pray that this camp will indeed be a good avenue to reconnect with God and with one another. Pray also for the children's program led by Ms. Emily Dass from Sitiawan Wesley. Tuesday, (May 28): Pray for the Lord's healing to all who are sick among us and also strength for caregivers who are caring for others and for the "wounded healer" ministry. Pray that the Lord will have mercy to bring relief in this increasingly intense and extreme heat throughout Asia who have issued health warnings due to the heat wave, forcing schools to suspend classes in the Philippines, Thailand, Cambodia, Myanmar, Vietnam, India and Bangladesh. Pray for the protection and prioritization of the rights and welfare of all Malaysian children, even those who are not citizens, so they can all receive the care, education, and healthcare they need.

Wednesday, (May 29): Pray for the Nation – Pray for Prime Minister Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim's political commitment to implement the National Anti-Corruption Strategy 2024-2028, aimed at enhancing governance and integrity in public service administration as well as economic growth. Continue to pray for the government's ongoing poverty eradication programmes, such as the Urban Community Economic Empowerment Programme, the People's Wellbeing Development Scheme for rural residents, and the Orang Asli Economic Development Programme, to achieve the government's goal of eliminating hardcore poverty this year. Pray for judiciary reforms to ensure the independence of the judiciary, as well as divine protection against the persistent assaults by powerful politicians to ensure justice prevails.

Thursday, (May 30): TRAC – Pray for the three churches in TRAC that has no pastoral appointments. They are Wesley Methodist Church, Kuala Lipis, Living Hope Methodist Church & Life Methodist Church, Puchong. Commit to the Lord the Lay leadership of the Church. Pray for God's guidance to be with the lay leaders of these churches as they lead their congregation. Pray for unity among and within the leadership. Pray for these churches to grow and to be enabled to walk in the will of God.

Friday, (May 31): As several Southeast Asian countries have experienced record-breaking temperatures, pray for God's mercy that He will provide us with strength and resilience to endure the heat. Pray that God will keep us well, especially those who are most vulnerable among us, including the elderly, children, and those with medical conditions. Pray for an adequate supply of power to run fans, air conditioners, and cool drinking water, particularly in hospitals, nursing homes and elderly homes. Pray for effective ventilation in schools and crowded areas.

<u>Saturday (June 1)</u>: Pray for the World: Pray for China and Taiwan to remain at peace. Pray for leaders who are committed to peace to find a diplomatic solution that satisfy the government and people of both nations, as well as to maintain the peace in East Asia. Pray for God's wisdom upon both presidents and leaders. Pray that God will raise more followers of Christ, and the message of Christ's love will break pride and hatred, bringing about enduring peace and harmony.
