PRAYERS FOR THE WEEK



<u>Sunday, (June 16)</u>: Pray for parents to teach their children to respect the Lord and to sternly rebuke them if they have done wrong in order to discipline them to be upright and fear the Lord at all times. Pray that parents will teach their children to obey the Lord for their own benefit by building a home environment (safe space) in which Christ is loved, honored, and worshipped. Pray that parents will teach their children to honor the Lord by understanding the gravity of sin and not be like Eli's sons, who ignored their father's warning of God's judgment on them.

Monday, (June 17): Church: We commit to the Lord the LCEC Mid-Year Review and LCEC meeting that will be held on June 21st (Fri.) night and 22nd (Sat.). May God's presence be upon the leaders as they reflect upon God's faithfulness and goodness for the church in the first half of the year, and they will seek God's heart and wisdom for the last half of the year. May God be the centre, leading the meeting. May He unite the hearts of the leaders to humbly desire to hear Him and submit to Him.
