Sunday, (June 23): Thank you, Lord, for all your saints in Christ who have come to faith in You. Pray that they will grow in grace and become more like Your Son, Jesus. Pray that we as the Lord's saints, knowing that we are all one in Him, may make our fellowship of our faith effective by knowing every good thing that is in us is for the glory of Christ. Pray that our great joy and consolation in Your love will refresh the hearts of Your saints for the Lord's praise and glory.

Monday, (June 24): Church - We come together before the Lord to ask for His healing hand to be upon brothers and sisters who are not well, or undergoing medical care, test and surgery. May the Lord grant them comfort and strength, and restore their health with His compassion and loving care. Pray for His protection upon each of their trips to and from the clinics and hospitals. May God bless the care givers with compassion and patience.

Tuesday, (June 25): Pray for Christians to aspire after the heights and depths of holiness, and to the full image of God, as John Wesley did. Pray for a unified heart in continuous prayer that the biblical prayer movement will continue to spread across our Methodist churches in unity, love and power. Pray for holy fear to permeate across the Methodist churches throughout our nation, especially among those serving in ministries entrusted to them.

Wednesday, (June 26): Pray for the Nation – Pray for Malaysia's education ministry system, which is highly committed to providing high-quality education that will equip all Malaysian students with outstanding knowledge and skills while protecting them from harmful ideologies. Continue to pray that regressive amendments are made and that headwinds are eliminated for children of permanent residents who are nonetheless classified as stateless. Pray that all Malaysians, regardless of ethnicity, religion or culture, may live in peace and unity defined by holiness and dignity, embodying the spirit of muhibbah taught by our forefathers since Independence Day.

Thursday, (June 27): TRAC – Commit to the Lord all members of the **Board of Ministry** and as well as all the **District Superintendents**. Pray for God's guidance to be with them at all times. Commit to the Lord the upcoming **BOM Retreat** that will take place from the **25th - 27th June**. Pray that as we come together to talk and discuss about ministerial matters, we will tune our ears towards God's voice and will allow our hearts and minds to be guided by God.

Friday, (June 28): As we approach the beginning of the second half of the year, we give thanks to God for His faithfulness and goodness towards Klang Wesley and all of us in the first half of 2024. May we continue to have our life and ministries under the lordship of Jesus and desire to have a closer relationship with Him through our personal quiet time with Him, such as meditation on His Word and prayer. May we also sometimes intentionally slow down during the day, opening our hearts to His Spirit and acknowledging His work in our lives.

Saturday (June 29): Pray for the World: Pray for the gospel to reach at least three billion people who have yet to hear the good news of our Lord Jesus Christ through churches worldwide, fulfilling the Great Commission. Pray for fair, transparent and integrity in major global elections this year, including India, Turkey, Pakistan, Thailand, Kazakhstan, U.K., and the US Presidential Election in November. Pray for renewed dialogue and skilful diplomacy to de-escalate the tensions between China and Taiwan.
