PRAYERS FOR THE WEEK

Sunday, (July14): Lord, we thank you for an incredible privilege of having the Holy Spirit living within us, reminding us that we are Your temple. Pray for the strength, courage and grace we need to live our lives as set apart for You in this fallen world, consecrating them to Your service and glory. Pray for Your sustenance grace, that we desire to be a living testament to Your goodness and love as our heavenly Father.

<u>Monday, (July15)</u>: Church – Pray for the Super Senior Cell meeting that is held once a month and is on July 17th this month.
