Sunday, (July 28): LORD, thank you for David's example, who despite the many problems, pressures, disappointments and pain that he was forced to endure, relied in Your never-failing promises and unending faithfulness. Pray that we will have a deeper trust in Your steadfast love that our hearts will rejoice in Your salvation and that we will sing praise of Your unfailing love for us.

Monday, (July 29): Church – As we desire to reconnect with God and people, may the Holy Spirit put into our hearts the names of family, friends or colleagues and lead us to pray that they will come to know Christ as their personal Lord and Saviour. We thank God that XEE workshop starts this Saturday, Aug.3. May many people be encouraged to join this workshop and learn how we can share with people the good news of our Lord Jesus Christ. Pray for the opportunities, courage and perseverance to share the good news in all seasons of life. May God's guidance be upon sister Rubina as she leads the XEE workshop.

Tuesday, (July 30): Pray and commit those who are ill to the Lord, and in His mercy, He will comfort them upon their sickbed, ease their suffering, and plead that no healing and restoration is too difficult for the Lord if it is His will. Pray for children that in their tender age that they will grow strong in faith, wisdom, in stature and in favor with God and men.
