As the athletes have trained and made much efforts for the game, may God grant them strength to persevere pressure and finish the game well. Pray that the Olympic games will serve as a platform for the demonstration of love, respect, courage, peace and unity, and this will encourage people who are watching, especially those who are facing challenging circumstances.
