Sunday, (Sept 22): Heavenly Father, we give thanks for the example of Nehemiah, who not only mourned the state of his nation and repented of their sin, but also trusted You to fulfill Your promises to Your people, Israel which You use to carry out Your plans in this nation. Pray that we as Your people will grieve and repent for the degrading state of the Church today while remaining steadfast in our faith in You to fulfil all Your promises to the Church. Pray that we be part of a faithful remnant that You use to carry out Your plans and purposes in a world to Your praise and glory, so that the world knows You are the Lord. Pray that our faith grows and our prayer life reflects the continuous communion with the Triune God, the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.

Monday, (Sept 23): Church: We thank God for His protection, blessings and guidance upon the kids camp that took place from Sep.14-17. May His Spirit continue to work in the hearts of kids so that they will desire to know Him more. We commit to the Lord, the adult baptism & membership class that starts on Sep.29. Pray for God's blessings and wisdom on our Yang di-Pertuan Agong, the rulers, the Prime Minister and the cabinet ministers as they lead the nation forward in unity and peace with one another. Pray that our leaders will always be guided by principles of righteousness and justice in their policies and acts in demonstrating fairness, compassion and equity.

Thursday, (Sept 26): TRAC : 49th Session MW Conference - Commit to the Lord the MW Conference that will take place from the 27th - 29th Sept in Kuantan. Pray for a meaningful time for all who would be attending the conference. Pray for the Lord's guidance to be upon Rev. Shaan Sya who is the plenary speaker, Rev. As we grieve for the people who are suffering, we continue to trust in the LORD and His sovereign hands. Pray that His light will shine in the darkness and His peace will reign. Continue to pray for God's justice and for His mercy to bring an end to war. Pray for the safe return of the hostages and captives to their families.
