Sunday, (Sept 29): Thank you gracious God that while we were helpless, Christ our Savior died for the ungodly. Thank you for this amazing love for us that we are justified by Christ's blood that we are saved and reconciled to you by the death of your Son. Pray that Paul's exhortation in Romans 5:3-5 will remind us that even in the midst of pain and suffering, we see God refining us, and we are called to endure knowing that our hope in Christ will not put us to shame. Pray that we will be encouraged in Romans 5:6-8 that displays God's incomprehensible love for us by sending his only Son to die for us, while we are sinners against him. Pray that we will share God's amazing gift of eternal salvation with those who have yet to know the saving knowledge of his Son, Christ Jesus, that forgiveness of sins and reconciliation with God can only be obtained by believing in his Son.

Monday, (Sept 30): Church: Pray for our church Local Conference that is held on October 2. Pray for God's presence to be among Rev Gaurri and leaders at the conference, as they reflect upon God's faithfulness and His work in and through Klang Wesley and the community. Pray for God's wisdom to be upon Rev Ashok Amarasingham, as he presides at Central District 2 local conferences as a District Superintendent. Pray for the work of the Holy Spirit to enable them to have an open sharing and to discern His leading as they bring matters to the Lord.

Tuesday, (Oct 1): Pray that churches around the world continue to be the light to their communities throughout many challenges and that they will mobilise the manpower resources to identify needs and opportunities to reach out in their communities. Pray for all humanitarian organisations, including Tearfund, which has trained over 300 church leaders in Columbia to assist their churches become places of protection for refugees. Pray for God's protection and grace to persecuted churches that they persevere in their faith and serve the communities of the persecuted because of their faith in Christ.

Wednesday, (Oct 2): Pray for the Nation: Pray for judicial integrity and reform, so that the judges will be guided by principles of justice and the law while remaining free from external influences and preserving the dignity of the legal process. Pray for a stronger commitment to environmental stewardship in urban development, so that future construction and city planning prioritise safety and sustainability. Pray for the nation's health insurance authorities to develop policies that balance the requirement for financial while not overburdening the well-being of the rakyat.

Thursday, (Oct 3): TRAC: Commit to the Lord the **Local Planning Committee (LPC)** of the 49th Session TRAC. This year the Annual Conference will be hosted by the Eastern District. Pray for all preparations to go on well and smoothly. Pray for all registrations to come in on time. Commit also to the Lord the election processes that will take place at the conference session. Above all commit to the Lord our Conference President, Rev. Joshua Khong as he leads the conference. Pray for the Holy Spirit to be with him as he presents his Presidential Address at the conference.

Friday, (Oct 4): Pray for God's comfort to be upon the people in the areas, especially in Kedah and Perlis that have been affected by recent floods, which also damaged much crops to be harvested soon. Pray for God's protection to be upon the evacuees and that their daily needs are met. As the nation may experience more rainfall in October, pray for God's protection and mercy that it will not result in floods or other calamities.

Saturday, (Oct 5): Pray for the World: Pray for a de-escalation in tensions pertaining to territorial disputes and navigation around South China Sea. Pray for peace to rule over the seas, islands and nations. Pray for wisdom and restraint among the nations around the area. Pray for renewed dialogue and skillful diplomacy so that issues will be resolved peacefully with fairness and consideration for all sides.
