Sunday, (Oct 27): Heavenly Father, we thank you for all Your preparations that led us to believe in You and trust in Jesus Christ as our Lord and Savior, who has the power to free us from the slavery of sin, the devil and fear of death in serving You. As the psalmist in Psalm 107 encourages us, may God grant us courage and boldness so that we who are redeemed by the Lord will share our story joyfully to others, testifying the greatness of our God. May those who hear the good news of our Lord Jesus be led by the Holy Spirit to believe that Lord Jesus is the living God and Saviour.

Saturday, (Nov 2): Pray for the World: Pray for the world leaders. Pray that God would protect them and their families and grant them grace as they deal with the challenges that come with their responsibilities. May God give them a heart that is devoted to justice and righteousness, and that they will seek to bring peace and work to make the world a better place for everyone. Pray that God will also grant them wisdom, discernment, strength and courage to lead with integrity and to make wise decisions that will bring about positive change in the lives of people, their country and the world. Pray that they will also have a personal encounter with our Lord Jesus, seek Him as their Lord and walk in His righteous way.
